Important information

This Statement of Fact is a record of the information provided by you, or by anyone acting on your behalf, to Assist Insurances Limited trading as Bundlebee ("Bundlebee") in connection with your application for insurance. Bundlebee has relied on this information when deciding whether to enter into the contract of insurance, the terms and conditions to apply, and the premium to be charged.

If you fail to answer questions honestly and with reasonable care, or if you make a negligent or fraudulent misrepresentation, Bundlebee may be entitled to apply the remedies available under the Consumer Insurance Contracts Act 2019. These remedies are proportionate and may include adjusting the terms of your Policy, the premium payable, or the settlement of a claim. In cases of fraudulent misrepresentation, your Policy may be voided. Please refer to your Policy Booklet for full details.

Please note that under Section 64(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1961 (as amended), it is an offence for any person, for the purpose of or in the course of obtaining a certificate of motor insurance, to commit fraud or to make any representation or statement (whether in writing, verbally, or by conduct) that they know to be false or misleading in any material respect.

All questions asked in connection with your application for insurance have been answered honestly and with reasonable care and any information voluntarily provided, was provided honestly and with reasonable care.
